SUMMER CONFERENCE PARKING PERMITS

Residential parking lots are enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. To park in these lots, Summer Conference parking permits may be purchased from Stanford Transportation'. Please note all parking permits are virtual and are only valid in: 'EA', 'ES', 'SJ', 'SO' and 'WE, or shared residential spaces: 'EA/C' or 'WE/C', etc. ALL PERMITS ARE VIRTUAL AND NON-REFUNDABLE.

Daily Permits \$6.00 per day

Daily Summer Conference permits are valid only in areas designated for Resident Student Permit lots including: 'EA', 'ES', 'SJ', 'SO', 'WE', and shared commuter parking spaces. These daily permits are ONLY valid for the date purchased. They are not valid for 'A', 'C', 'Visitor', or 'SH' parking.

Monthly Summer Conference Permits \$47.00 (6-30 days)

Monthly Summer Conference Parking Permits are valid only in areas designated for Resident Student Permit lots including: 'EA', 'ES', 'SJ', 'SO', and 'WE' parking. Monthly permits are not valid for 'A', 'C', 'Visitor', or 'SH' parking. The calendar month permit is ONLY valid for the month purchased.

HOW TO PURCHASE

You may check out as a guest. An account does not need to be created to purchase or manage a permit. Parking permits should only be purchased as needed. Please review your order for accuracy before checking out. All parking permits are paid in full when purchased and are non-refundable. Links below will be active starting June 1, 2025

HOW TO PURCHASE BULK PERMITS

If 20 or more permits are needed on a certain day or date range, an Event Request Form can be submitted to Stanford Transportation a minimum of 10 days before the event via the AIMS permit system. A voucher will be created and shared with you. Your group is responsible for sharing the voucher codes and permit purchase instructions with those needing to park. If Stanford Transportation creates a voucher code and less than 20 cars register, they will charge the PTA account for the price of the permit times 20 cars, which is the minimum. If more than 20 cars are registered, they will charge the going rate (daily or monthly rate depending on which voucher code is used) for the number of cars registered. Requests can only be submitted by a Stanford employee

ENFORCEMENT

Parking regulations are strictly enforced as follows:

A', 'C', and 'Shared' (resident/commuter) lots are enforced Monday-Friday, 6 a.m. - 4 p.m., (excluding university holidays). You are free to park in these areas after enforcement hours; unless otherwise posted.

Vehicles parked in red zones or spaces with permit designations (e.g., 'A' zones, 'C' zones, Resident Fellow (RF), Service Vehicle, Handicapped, Special Permit Only stalls, etc.) that differ from what is listed on the parking permit will be ticketed.

Resident Lots posted as 'EA', 'ES', 'SJ', 'SO', and 'WE' parking are enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Most visitor parking areas are enforced 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday, (excluding university holidays); all posted signs and time limits must be observed.

PARKING FOR THOSE WITH DISABILITIES

Disabled person placards issued by any state are honored on campus and permit parking in most designated spaces, including visitor spaces, blue-marked handicap spaces, service vehicle spaces, commuter lots, and residential lots. However, posted time limits still apply.

Please note that state-issued disabled placards are not valid in red zones, Resident Fellow (RF) spaces, "Special Permit Only" parking, or "No Parking" areas.
